## WINTER DEVELOPMENTS...

We have some exciting plans which we are working on over the winter.

Here are just a few...

- You may have noticed that **new outdoor lighting** has started to appear around park. It has been carefully designed so that it doesn't interfere with our nocturnal wildlife. The wiring should soon be finished, then we'll be ready to switch on!
- We are very excited about the **new 18-hole Crazy Golf Course** being built in the New Field! Equipment will be available to hire during shop hours when the course opens. We are hoping this will be late May / early June but will keep you posted!

### CHANGES TO PITCHES

Please remember, if you would like to make any changes to your pitch, you must consult with the park owners first. This includes any visible additions such as lights.

### RECYCLING

Please use the recycling bins for paper, card, cans and glass - these should not be placed in the general waste bins. Anything too large for the bins should be taken to the tip.

### DOG WALKING

Please can we remind any dog owners that dog walking should not take place in the camping fields or near pitches. Please make the most of the woods and public footpaths.

For everybody's security and safety, it is essential that your caravan is insured and that your insurance details are provided on your Seasonal Agreement. Compass Insurance are a reputable firm who can provide competitive rates for seasonal sited touring caravans. Please ask in reception for more details.

### 2024 Christmas Closure Dates

This year, we are only closing for 1 week from the 22nd December, re-opening on the 30th December.



Please **talk to us** if you are unsure of anything or there is something you feel we can improve on. Guests reviews and feedback form the basis for improvements.

We'd appreciate it if you could **keep the exterior of your caravan and awning clear of leaves and as clean as possible**. Any **gazebos should be dismantled** for the winter period.
